Epistle reading (Hebrews 6:13 - 20)

Reader: A Reading from the first Letter of St. Paul to
 the Hebrews

Priest: Let us be attentive!

Reader: **Brothers and Sisters! God has made His promise to Abraham; since He had no greater One to swear by, He took an oath Himself, saying, “Indeed, more and more I will bless you and multiply you.” Whereupon Abraham waited patiently, and obtained the**

promise. Men, since they have something greater than themselves to swear by, will confirm their word by an oath, which puts an end to all controversy; and God, in the same way, wishing to show more abundantly to the heirs of the promise that His design was irrevocable, pledged Himself by an oath. Two unalterable assurances, in which God cannot deceive, bring a powerful encouragement to us who have come to cling to the hope in view as an anchor to the soul. This hope is firm and sure, it reaches that inner sanctuary beyond the veil, where Jesus, our predecessor has entered already, having been made a High Priest forever according to the order of Melchisedek

Gospel Reading

(Mark 9: 17 - 31)

At that time a man came to Jesus kneeling before Him and saying, “Master, I have brought to You my son, who is possessed by a dumb spirit; and whenever it seizes him, it flings him down and he foams and gnashes his teeth and he becomes stiff. And I told Your disciples to cast it out but they could not do it.”

And Jesus answered him saying, “O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I have to bear with you? Bring him to me !” So they brought the boy to Jesus. And the spirit, as soon as it saw Jesus threw the boy at once into convulsion so that he fell on the ground, writhing and foaming. Jesus asked his father, “How long has this been happening to him?” “From childhood,” replied the father, “often it has thrown him into the fire and into the water in order to kill him. But if you can do anything, help us and have pity on us.” And Jesus said to him, “If you can believe, to him who believes everything is possible.”
