Epistle: (Galatians 1 : 11 - 19)

Priest: Wisdom!

Reader: **A Reading from the Letter of St. Paul
to the Galatians**

Priest: Let us be attentive!

Reader: **Brothers and Sisters!**

For I give you to understand that the gospel which was preached by me is not of man. For I did not receive it from man, nor was I taught it; but I received it by a revelation of Jesus Christ. For you have heard of my former manner of life in Jerusalem; how beyond all measure I persecuted the Church of God and ravaged it. And how I advanced in Judaism above many of my contemporaries in my nation, showing much more zeal for the traditions of my fathers. But when it pleased Him, who from my mother's womb set me apart and called me by His grace, to reveal His Son to me, that I might preach Him among the gentiles, immediately, without taking counsel with flesh and blood, and without going up to Jerusalem to those who were appointed apostles before me, I retired into Arabia, and again returned to Damascus. Then after three years, I went to Jerusalem to see Peter, and I remained with him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other apostles, except James, the brother of the Lord.

Gospel

(Luke 7: 11 - 15)

At that time, Jesus went to a town called Naim; and His disciples and a large crowd went with Him. As He drew near the gate of the town, behold, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow - and a large gathering from the town was with her. And the Lord seeing her had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." And He went up and He touched the stretcher; and the bearers stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you 'Arise'." And he, who was dead, sat up and began to speak. And Jesus gave him to his mother. But fear seized upon all and they began to glorify God, saying, "A great prophet has risen among us," and "God has visited his people."
