Priest: Let us be attentive!

Reader: **Brothers and Sisters!**

See in what large characters I have written to you in my own hand.

They who wish to boast in the flesh (before people), these are the ones who are insisting on your being circumcised, so that the cross of Christ may not bring persecution on them. For those who are circumcised do not themselves observe the Law, but they want you to be circumcised so that they may boast in your flesh.

God forbid that I should boast, except in the cross of our Lord, Jesus Christ, through which the world is crucified to me, and I to the world. For in Christ Jesus, neither circumcision means anything or uncircumcision, but a new creature. Peace and mercy to all who follow this rule, and to God's Israel.

Let no one cause me any further trouble, for I bear the scars of the Lord Jesus on my body.

Brothers and sisters! The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

Gospel

(Luke 16: 19 - 31)

The Lord told this parable:

“ There was once a rich man, who was clothed in purple and fine linen, and feasted sumptuously every day. And there was a beggar called Lazarus, who lay at his gate, covered with sores. And he wished to be fed with the crumbs that fell from the rich man’s table. And the dogs came to lick his sores. Time went on; the beggar died and was carried by the angels into Abraham’s bosom. The rich man also died and was buried. And suffering in hell, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he said with a loud voice, “Father Abraham, have mercy on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am tormented in this flame!” But Abraham said, “Child, remember that you did receive your good fortune in your lifetime, just as Lazarus received ill fortune; so now he is in delight and you are in torment. And besides all this there is a great abyss between us and you, so that there is no passing from our side to yours nor crossing over from us to you.” Wherefore he said, “Father, I pray you, send him to my father’s house, for I have five brothers, to give them a warning, so that they may not come in their turn to this place of torment.” Abraham said to him, “They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them!” But he replied, “No, Father Abraham! They will not listen to Moses, but if a messenger comes to them from the dead, they will repent.” But Abraham answered him, “If they do not listen to Moses and to the prophets, they will not believe, though one should rise from the dead.”
