The weakness is being brought out in the course of a merger that began last summer between the Common Market proper and two sister organizations that deal with important sectors of industry—coal, steel and nuclear energy. All three have the same six members: France, West Germany, Italy, Belgium, Holland and Luxembourg.

## AIMS FOR UNITY

Aim of the Common Market is to unify the economies of its members. Its most successful work has been done on breaking down the tariff walls among them and getting them together on farm policy.

The European Coal and Steel Community was the first to be formed. It was considered a big
