TORONTO (CP) — Every time a woman uses baby powder for her child's diaper rash she could be applying organisms that cause infection, a scientist told the Toronto section of the Chemical Institute of Canada. Dr. G. W. Riedel, an industrial microbiologist, said a study of 28 baby powders found potential trouble-making organisms in 11 of them.
